Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, thank you for all the parental understanding shown and shared with us yesterday linked to our later school opening decision. It is always very difficult to make school closure or late opening decisions without being able to look into the future. We do appreciate that you are aware these decisions are made to keep everyone as safe as possible.

The pupils have had a positive week of learning - please view our social media posts for examples of the learning that has taken place.

### Message from Mrs Norton:

'First week back after half term and straight back into the sport calendar with the girls year 5/6 tournament. 7 girls were selected to play for us made up of 2 football players, 1 netball player, 3 rugby players and 1 player being completely new to football. The first game was against St Columb Major, we started very timidly, a little scared of the tackles even, but as the game continued Summercourt grew into it with some 'screamers' of shots from Meme to give us a 3-0 win. Second game got underway against Bishops school, Summercourt became more confident in this game with all the girls up front having a chance at the goal to score. Eventually the girls were rewarded with more goals and one being scored by a rugby girl. Summercourt moved into the play offs for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place with only conceding 1 goal in total and 2 straight wins. Summercourt then had the challenge of Indian Queens and Newquay Juniors, both showing to be very good teams. First came Indian Queens, this was a very physical game straight from the off with both teams showing 'fire in their belly' for the win and ended with a draw. Next up was Newquay Juniors and we had established, after watching all the games, that we needed a win to come away as winners overall. After a bit of passing the ball around and a penalty, we eventually managed to make the break and scored with a second and third goal following after in a short space of time.
