Dear Parents and Carers.

Our pupils have had a brilliant full week of learning, diving into their new project enquiry questions. Please take a look at our social media sites for examples of the learning being completed.

#### PE Kit/Uniform - Polite reminder

Due to health and safety requirements we are unable to allow pupils to participate in PE without the appropriate clothing/kit. Please could all pupils have their PE kits in school Monday to Friday each week, every day.

Where possible we do supply spare PE kit to pupils who forget to bring their kit in and enable pupils to participate wearing their school uniform/school trainers if this meets the health and safety requirements of the activity.

During times where we have high numbers forgetting to bring their kit in we are unable to supply the spare PE kits. In these instances, pupils would be encouraged to watch the PE lesson to still learn the skills and key knowledge being taught whilst also reading their reading book when appropriate. (If a pupil was to become upset by watching a PE session they can be supported in another classroom).
