These are our focus words for the next 2 weeks. We will be investigating the underlined phonemes.

- Can you read all 15 words?
- Do you know the definitions of all 15 words?
- What sound does the underlined phoneme make?
- Can you think of any other words that have the same phoneme spelt in the same way.?
- How many of these words can you spell? Try to practise any that you find tricky.

1	break	If a pupil can spell 'break', then they know that <ea> can spell the sound /eɪ/ in the following words: great, steak, breakdown, greatest, heartbreak.</ea>
2	brochure	If a pupil can spell 'brochure', then they know that <ure> can spell the sound /ə/ in the following words: treas<u>ure</u>, meas<u>ure</u>, pleas<u>ure</u>, enclos<u>ure</u>, expos<u>ure</u>.</ure>
3	build	If a pupil can spell 'build', then they know that <ui> can spell the sound /ɪ/ in the following words: building, guilt, quilt, guilty, builder.</ui>
4	bury	If a pupil can spell 'bury', then they know that <u> can spell the sound /ε/ in the following words: b<u>u</u>ried, b<u>u</u>rial, b<u>u</u>rying, Banb<u>u</u>ry, Canterb<u>u</u>ry.</u>
5	calendar	If a pupil can spell 'calendar', then they know that <ar> can spell the sound /ə/ in the following words: popul<u>ar</u>, caterpill<u>ar</u>, doll<u>ar</u>, regul<u>ar</u>, simil<u>ar</u>.</ar>
6	century	If a pupil can spell 'century', then they know that <t> can spell the sound /tʃ/ in the following words: fortune, culture, capture, factual, mixture.</t>
7	chalet	If a pupil can spell 'chalet', then they know that <ch> can spell the sound /ʃ/ in the following words: chef, machine, brochure, parachute, chicane.</ch>
8	character	If a pupil can spell 'character', then they know that <ch> can spell the sound /k/ in the following words: <u>ch</u>emist, <u>ch</u>orus, <u>ch</u>ord, stoma<u>ch</u>, an<u>ch</u>or.</ch>
9	chef	If a pupil can spell 'chef', then they know that <ch> can spell the sound /ʃ/ in the following words: machine, parachute, chic, brochure, chalet.</ch>
10	chemist	If a pupil can spell 'chemist', then they know that <ch> can spell the sound /k/ in the following words: stomach, echo, scheme, choir, technology.</ch>



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11	chorus	If a pupil can spell 'chorus', then they know that <ch> can spell the sound</ch>		
12	circle	If a pupil can spell 'circle', then they know that <le> can spell the sound /l/ in the following words: sparkle, dazzle, tickle, apple, purple.</le>		
13	closure	If a pupil can spell 'closure', then they know that <s> can spell the sound /ʒ/ in the following words: pleasure, measure, treasure, leisure, enclosure.</s>		
14	collision	If a pupil can spell 'collision', then they know that <si> can spell the sound /ʒ/ in the following words: vision, television, confusion, explosion, occasion.</si>		
15	compassionate	If a pupil can spell 'compassionate', then they know that <ssi> can spell the sound /ʃ/ in the following words: compa<u>ssi</u>onately, commi<u>ssi</u>on, confe<u>ssi</u>on, compre<u>ssi</u>on, impre<u>ssi</u>onable.</ssi>
